Update on the following:

Philippines: The Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) has issued a level three (3) Travel Health Notice for the Philippines due to elevated level of Covid-19. The Philippine health ministry confirmed the spread of Omicron coronavirus variant around Manila and all throughout the country as infections hit a record high daily. For this reason, the Philippines is still extremely strict on who can come into the country. The chief implementer of the National Task Force against Covid-19 said that the government's constitutional mandate to protect the health and welfare of the people should be the basis for the implementation of mandatory vaccination in the country.

Ministries: The pandemic crisis has forced education system worldwide to moved activities and schooling online and continue despite school closure. We praise the Lord for the opening of School Year (SY) 2022-2023 with twelve students and three (3) teachers. Our teachers must adapt to new concepts and modes of delivery of teaching as ordered by the Department of Education. We appreciate your prayers for our deaf students and teachers. On another note, the Omicron variant did not temper the normal Christmas celebration of the Lord's ministries in the Philippines. There was limited number and crowding of people at the event in each space. For this reason, our people had three Christmas Celebrations. The deaf school was celebrated on December 16th, the church was celebrated on December 19th and the young people was celebrated on December 21st. We are truly grateful for Ms. Faye Dykes and Joyce's Kids for donating Physical Education uniforms, gym shoes and supplies for our staff and students. Because of your extra gifts, our people were able to have a wonderful Christmas. In addition to these benefits, we praise the Lord for Pastor Mark Mckee and Saints of Rock Springs Baptist Church, Rev. and Mrs. Mayfield, Chris and Julie Lindeman and Jim and Sue Wylie for donating school and medical supplies and shipment of boxes to the Philippines.

Chris and Carol's health update: We praise the Lord for Carol's health. Her appointment last December 16-2021, with her pulmonologist went well. She is down to one liter of oxygen moving around and zero liter when resting. Although her health has improved significantly, her lungs are not fully recovered. She still has the chronic cough and coughing spells. Concerning Chris, he suffered a massive stroke last Thursday, January 27th. He is in the ICU at Atlanta Piedmont. His surgery for blood clot retrieval was not successful. He has a large clot and will require craniotomy. Without the surgery, he will deteriorate. With the surgery, the outcome can be better but left side paralysis. We appreciate your prayers for Chris. God is the God of impossibilities. We ask that you also pray for the team of the neurosurgeons and nurses that they be blessed with the wisdom and grace needed to provide the best care possible for Chris. From the bottom of our hearts, thank you for your prayers and faithful support of the Lord's ministries in the Philippines. We love you!
